BSC DOES NOT ACCEPT CHECKS!!!

1. All first stages should be environmentally protected. NO dives deeper than 50ft.
2. We have no water patrol during the winter; please stay near the shorelines for easy exits. We recommend you carry a cellular telephone for emergencies. Dial 911.
3. If you leave the premises, you must show your admission receipt **inside** the dive store when you return.
4. A photo certification card, current membership card or instructor pass are required for entry. All others must show photo ID inside the dive store when registering for the day, and at the ticket check at the entry gate.
5. Gates will lock promptly at 5:00pm. Prepare your dive plan accordingly; be out of the water by 4:15pm and off the premises by 5:00pm. Special arrangements are possible if requested at least one week in advance.

- * No Solo Diving
- * No Swimming or Cliff Diving
- * No Fishing or Spear Fishing
- * No Pets (it's the law, guide dogs excepted)

Winter SCUBA Diving guidelines according to certification level:

- Always follow the diving standards according to your training agency
- Open Water: 30ft. maximum depth
- Advanced Open Water: 50ft. maximum depth
- Deep Diver Certified: Divers below 60ft. should have a redundant air source (i.e. pony bottle). Reduce your work load by at least 1/3 due to cold water conditions
